What is an UltimateMamm™ ?

Monitoring breast health is so much more than a basic mammogram. Having greater knowledge about your risk helps your providers more accurately monitor your breast health.

- An UltimateMamm™ goes beyond simple screening and helps your healthcare team assess and monitor your risk for breast cancer.
- Our team will ask you a series of 7 simple questions about your breast health and history. This information will be put into the National Cancer Institute Breast Cancer Risk Assessment Tool*.
- The answers to these questions will help us determine if you may be at increased risk for developing breast cancer.
- If your score indicates an increased risk we will discuss this with you and your primary care physician. You and your physician should look at your risk and develop a monitoring plan that fits your risk.
- If your score is in the normal range, we will simply re-assess your score at next year's mammogram.

* The National Cancer Institute Breast Cancer Risk Assessment Tool only considers the risks associated with invasive breast cancer.

An Ultimate Weapon in the Fight Against Breast Cancer

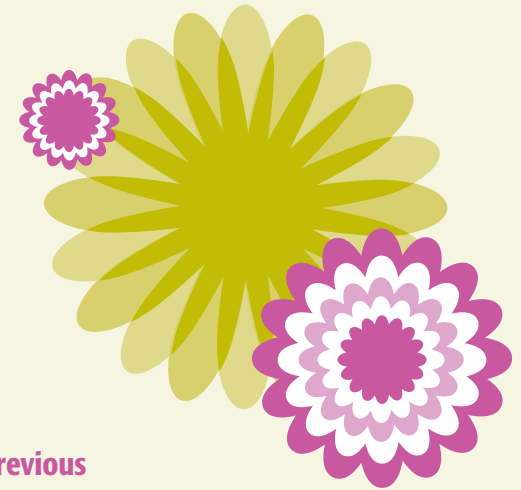
Early detection of breast cancer with mammography means that treatment can be started earlier in the course of the disease, possibly before it has spread. Results from randomized clinical trials and other studies show that mammography can help reduce the number of deaths from breast cancer among women ages 40-74.

Ultimate Screening Mamm

- If you are getting a screening mammogram, your score will be provided to the radiologist so he/she has a full picture when reviewing your mammogram.
- If your results are normal, we will send you a letter to let you know.

Ultimate Diagnostic Mamm

- Approximately 10-15% of women will require additional views of their breasts following a screening mammogram. This is not unusual, so don't be alarmed. These additional views provide the radiologist with a closer look at your breasts to rule out any problems. This study is referred to as a diagnostic mammogram.



Previous Mammogram Images

It is essential that our breast specialists have the opportunity to compare your previous mammogram images to your current images. This ensures the highest quality result. If your previous films are from another facility and are not at RMI at the time of your UltimateMamm™, we will ask you to provide us with the name of the facility where your previous mammograms were performed. If we do not have your previous images, your final results may be delayed.
