Summary

Essentials Duties and Responsibilities

Always maintains professional attitude when taking on Stats and fitting in a patient when needed

Operation of imaging equipment such as x-ray machine, fluoroscope, mammography and bone densitometry. Moves x-ray equipment into specified position and adjusts equipment controls to set exposure factors such as time and distance. Ability to use and troubleshoot CR equipment.

Positions patient on examining table and adjusts immobilization devices to obtain optimum views of specified area of body requested by Physician.

Explains procedures to patient to reduce anxieties and obtain patient cooperation, obtains proper history information and exam consent forms when applicable.

Practices radiation protection techniques to minimize radiation to patient and staff.

IV's - must be proficient in starting, maintaining and administering contrast.

Drug/Crash Cart - must be able to identify and know the uses of the items in the crash cart and possess the ability to assist the Radiologist during a drug reaction/emergency in a calm and efficient manner.

Must be knowledgeable in the fundamentals and comfortable in the every day use of PAC's, Powerscribe, Document Scanning and Management Pages and possess the general computer skills required to complete the tasks at hand. Must also have the ability to print films from both CR machine and e-film print station and burn CD's. Able to use document-scanning equipment properly to scan in history info etc...

Ability to hang films on alternators when needed (over reads and mammograms).
